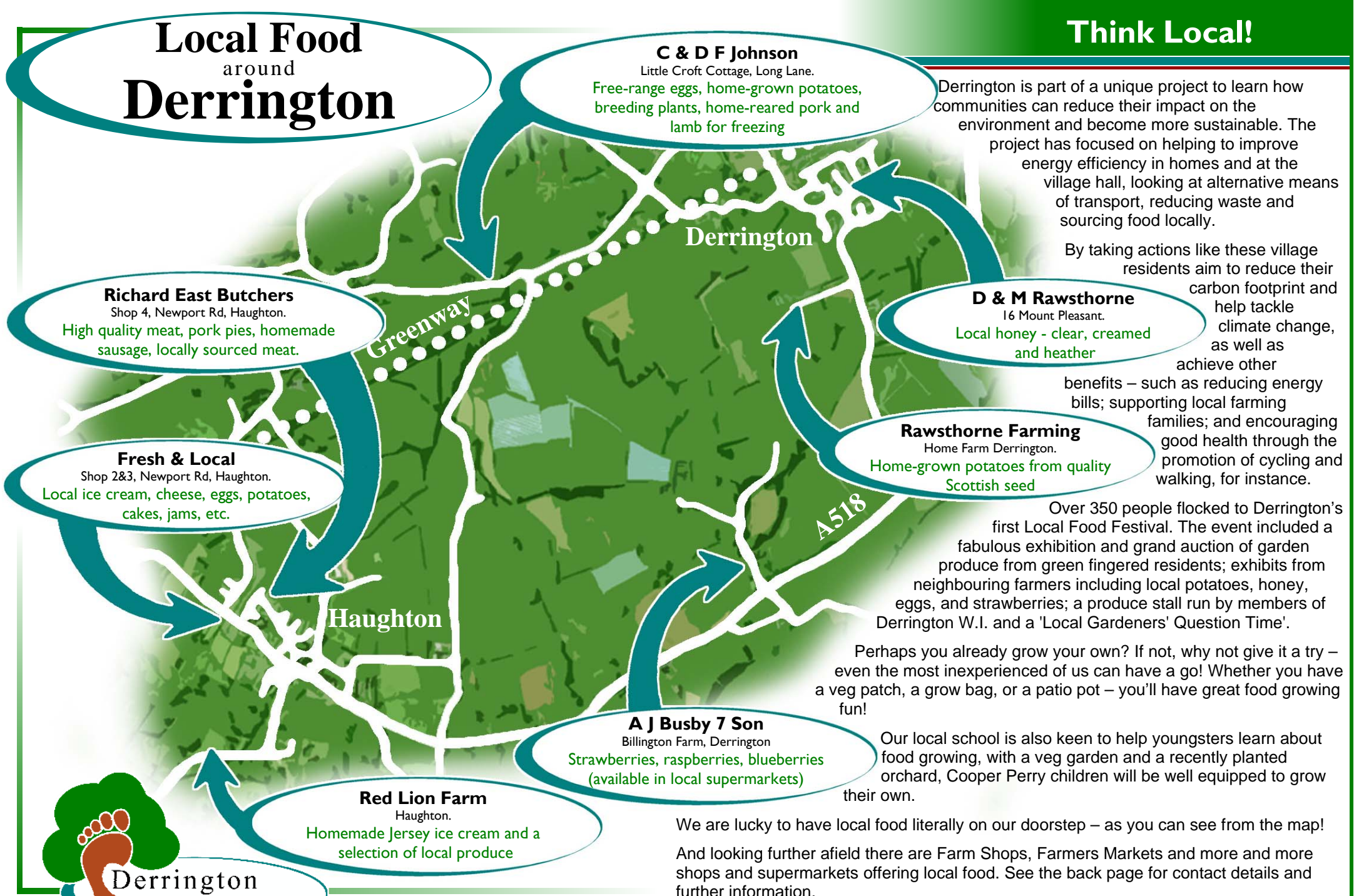


Local Food around Derrington

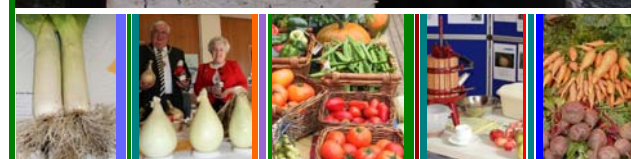
