Stafford Borough Council has prepared a Draft Statement of Community Involvement (SCI) as part of the intended Local Development Framework (LDF) for the whole of the Borough. The SCI sets out how the community will be engaged in the preparation of the LDF and in significant planning applications. If and when the Statement of Community Involvement is adopted it will form a Local Development Document within the Local Development Framework.

Copies of the Draft Statement of Community Involvement are available for inspection free of charge at Planning and Engineering Reception, Stafford Borough Council, 3rd Floor, Civic Centre Riverside Stafford, during normal office hours Monday – Thursday 08.30 – 17.00, Friday 08.30 – 16.30. Representations should specify the matters to which they relate and the grounds on which they are made. To help in the making of representations a form is available from at the address quoted below but its use is not obligatory. All representations should be sent in writing to the Head of Planning and Engineering, Stafford Borough Council, Civic Centre, Riverside, Stafford, ST16 3AQ. They may also be accompanied by a request to be notified at a specified address of the publication of the submission document.

Only those representations which are made in writing and arrive at the address specified above within the six week period ending at 12 noon on Monday the 22nd November 2004 will have a right to be considered.
