AAC1 Minutes

Minutes of the meeting held on 26 March 2025 as published on 7 April 2025 were agreed as a correct record.

AAC2 Apologies

AAC3 Stafford Borough Council External Audit Plan - Year Ended 31 March 2024

Received the report of Azets highlighting the key elements of their proposed audit strategy and providing an overview of the planned scope and timing of the statutory external audit of the Council for the year ended 31 March 2024.

The Deputy Chief Executive - Resources and Section 151 Officer was pleased to report the removal of the Section 24 Notice representing significant progress for the Council and confirmed that statement of accounts reporting was now up to date.

The Chairman of the Committee welcomed these major steps forward and thanked Officers for their efforts in this area of work.
