CAB30 Minutes

Minutes of the meeting held on 7 October 2021 as published on 8 October 2021 were agreed as a correct record.

CAB31 New Local Plan 2020-2040: Updated Programme

Considered a report recommending that the New Local Plan programme be updated, with the latest revision of the Local Development Scheme brought into effect from 17 November 2021, replacing the existing scheme as published in September 2019.

The Cabinet Member, Economic Development and Planning Portfolio highlighted Paragraph 2 of the report and concluded her comments by recommending that said proposal be approved.

The Cabinet subsequently voted on the recommendation which was declared to be carried.

RESOLVED:- that the proposal of the Cabinet Member, Economic

Development and Planning Portfolio be approved as

follows:-

That the Local Development Scheme be brought into effect from 17 November 2021 as an update for the New Local Plan 2020-2040.

CAB32 Fees and Charges Review 2022

Considered a report proposing to the Council the Fees and Charges for 2022.

The Deputy Leader highlighted paragraph 5.4 of the report which detailed those fees which had been frozen, specifically referring to the garden waste charge, before referring colleagues to the proposal as set out in paragraph 2.

Cabinet subsequently voted on the recommendation which was duly declared to be carried.

RESOLVED:- that the proposal of the Deputy Leader be approved as follows:-

That the proposed Fees and Charges for 2022 be recommended to Council for approval.

The Leader of the Council noted that some of the fees and charges as set out in the report were imposed nationally and were not under control by the Council.

CAB33 Gambling Act 2005 - Statement of Principles 2022 - 2025

Considered a report noting the Councils requirement to prepare and publish a revised and updated Statement of Principles relating to the Gambling Act 2005, as per section 349 of the Gambling Act 2005.

The Cabinet Member, Environment Portfolio detailed the purpose of the report and described the Councils roll in relation to this matter and confirmed that no responses were received to the associated consultation. Councillor Price highlighted Paragraph 2 of the report and concluded his comments by recommending that said proposals be approved.

The Cabinet subsequently voted on the recommendations which were declared to be carried.

RESOLVED:- that the proposals of the Cabinet Member, Environment Portfolio be approved as follows:-

That:- (i) it be noted the revised Statement of Principles had been subject to full consultation;

- (ii) it be noted there were no consultation responses received;
- (iii) it be recommended Full Council approve the proposed Statement of Principles at its meeting of 23 November 2021.

Councillor Price paid tribute to Officers of the Licensing and Legal Departments for their efforts in this area of work.
