What is a Garden Community?

A Garden Community is a special type of large-scale development that is shaped by the landscape. A garden community is founded on principles of community inclusion, vibrant neighbourhoods, and sustainability.

Stafford Borough Council secured Garden Community Status in 2019 supporting our vision for housing and employment growth in Meecebrook.

It is a community that will be created together with local people to provide new homes, schools, transport links and jobs in the north of **Stafford Borough**, and be developed in tune with the local landscape.

The scheme is supported through the Government's Garden Community Programme and the council has received over £1 million of government funding so far, which is being used to carry out technical studies to develop more detailed plans for the key infrastructure required, such as highway improvements, schools, water and energy provision - to support a sustainable development.

Homes England

Homes England is the government's housing and regeneration agency. The Agency supports the delivery of housing supply, housing guality and placemaking, helping to create jobs and drive local economic growth.

The vision for Meecebrook is set out through 12 unique charter points, which help guide the design and delivery process for years to come.

It is our ambition that Meecebrook will be shaped and defined by the existing landscape of green space and water courses.

Meecebrook's vision will be for a garden community that is sustainable in all forms by reducing carbon use and being a self-sufficient community.
