

Stone Leisure Centre Public Consultation March 2017

A consultation exercise took place with the local community on the design and facility mix of the proposed new leisure centre between 20 and 27 March 2017.

Consultation included a web site based survey and displays and the opportunity for face to face Q & A sessions at the existing Westbridge Park Leisure Centre.

A summary of the results from the consultation shows that:

79% of respondents felt that it was very important or important for the new facility to bring the provision of the swimming pool, gym and fitness studios under one roof.

The majority of respondents stated that the most important facilities in a leisure centre for them were a swimming pool and fitness gym.

On a score of 1 – 5 where, 1 is hate it and 5 love it, 69% of respondents rated the overall appearance at a score of 4 to 5.

Overall impressions of the scheme on a similar scoring matrix to the above confirmed that 67% of respondents rated it at a score of 4 to 5.

A total of 91.75% of respondents stated that they would use the new leisure centre.

The majority of responses to the consultation exercise were very positive. The proposals were universally seen as being a benefit to Stone and its local community. A number of specific issues were raised in relation to the scope of the proposals, which subsequently have been incorporated into the design. These are as follows:-

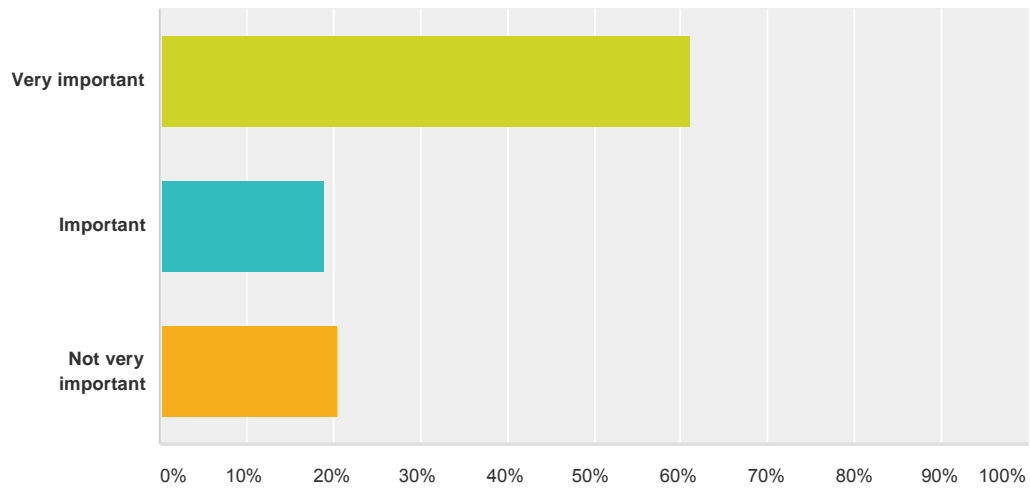
1. The amount of glazing into the pool hall at ground floor level has been reduced by introducing solid brickwork panels in the central section of the covered walkway (associated with the cycle parking area).
2. The fenestration pattern of studio 1 at first floor was altered to create a more flowing arrangement of glazing across the main façade.
Internally,
3. The stores associated with studios 1 and 2 at first floor have been omitted to allow studio 2 to be enlarged to cater for larger group sizes.

It should be noted that the Borough Council will be carrying out an additional consultation exercise in late summer on the provision and location of improved play facilities in the area including a Multi-Use Games Area and Skate park.

Here are more specific results from the consultation:

Do you currently use leisure facilities in Stone?

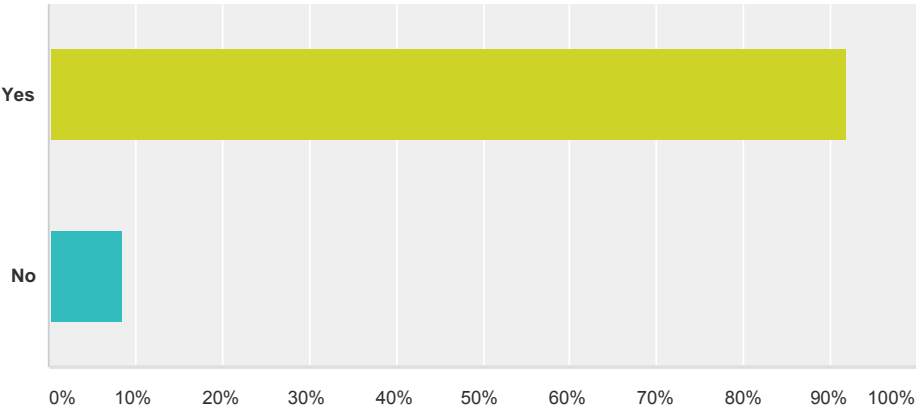

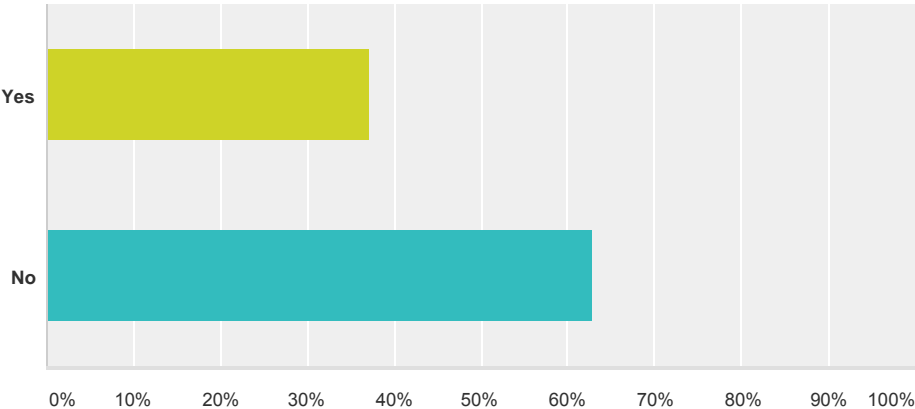

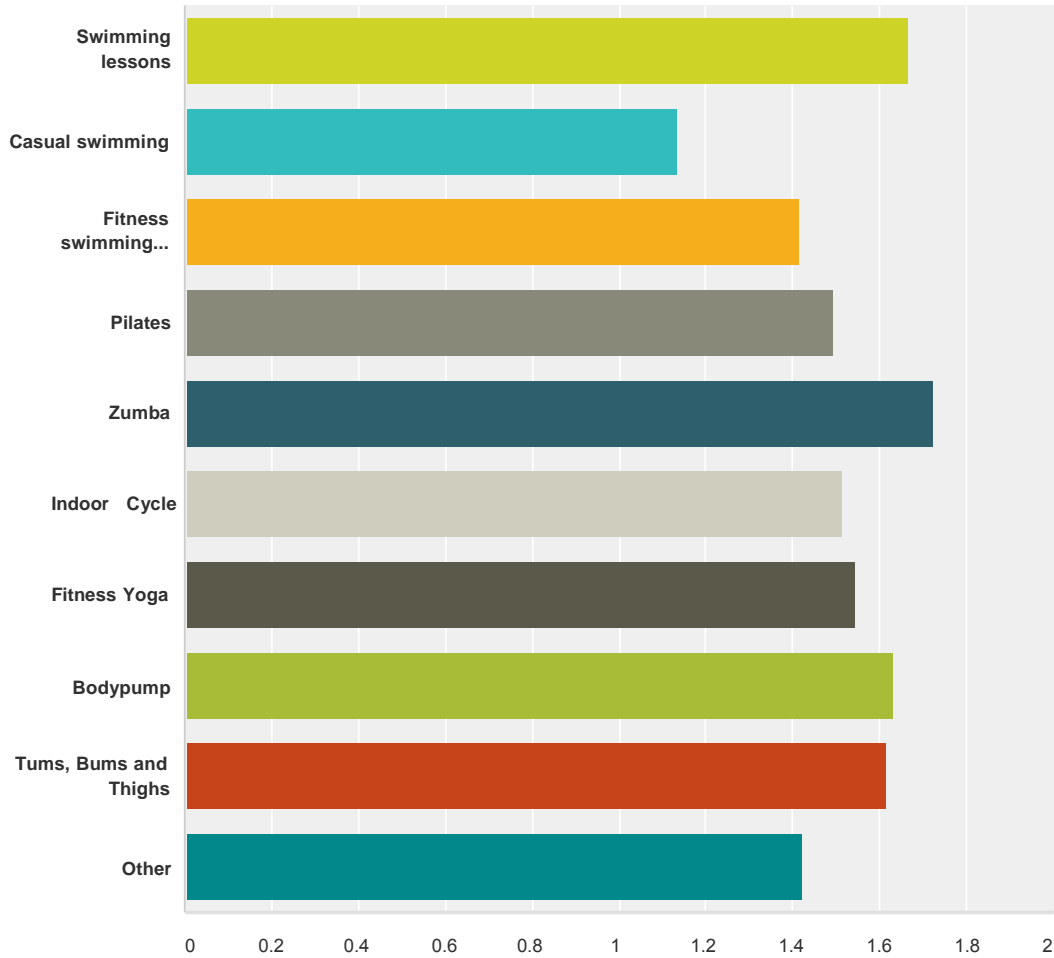

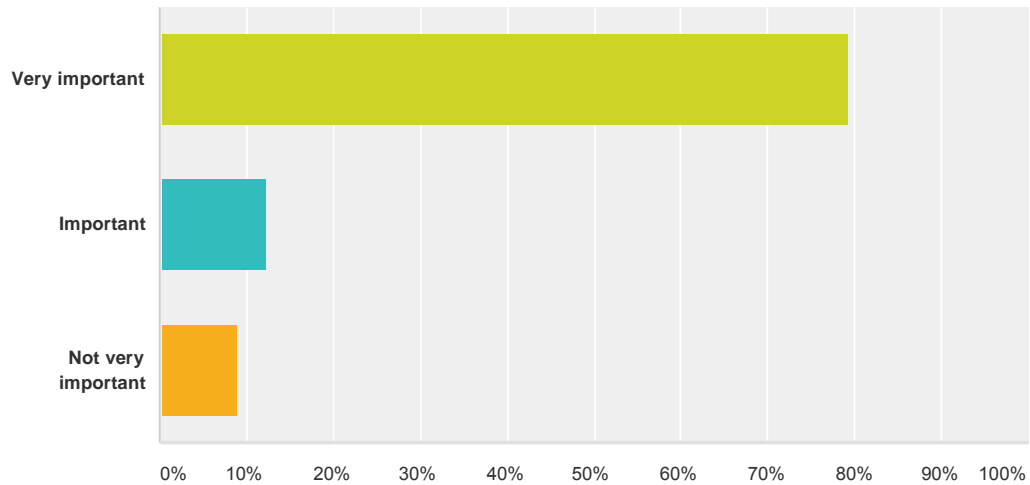

How important is the proposed 2 hours free parking for users of the facility?

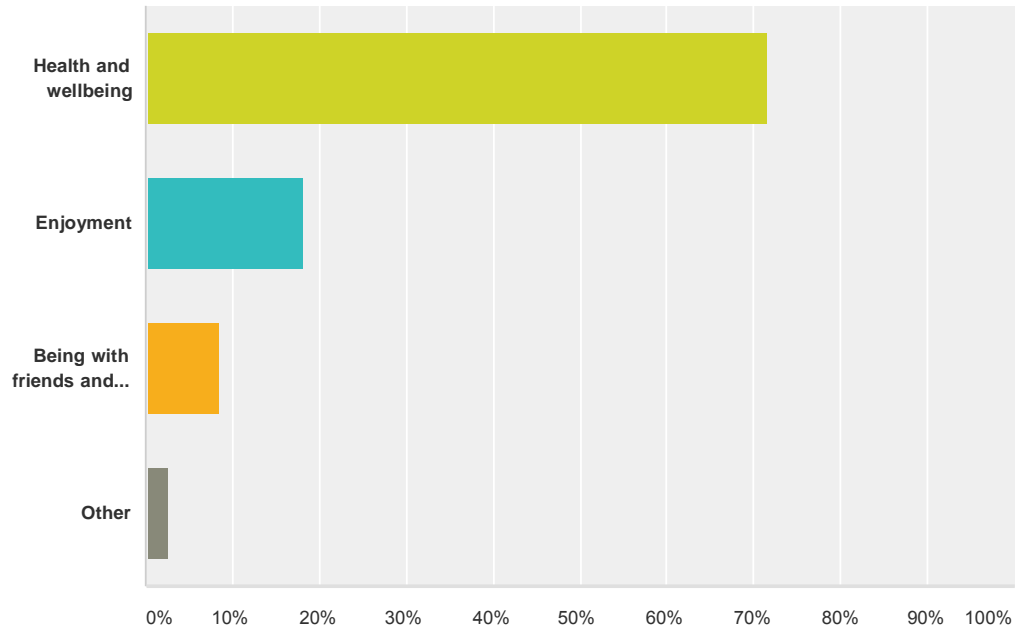

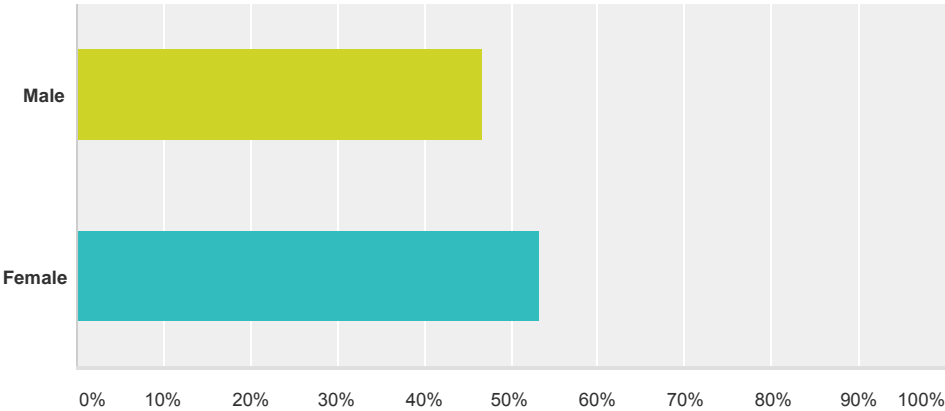
