Stafford Borough Council has prepared a Core Strategy Development Plan Document (DPD) as part of the intended Local Development Framework (LDF) for the whole of the Borough. The Core Strategy DPD sets out the vision, sustainable development statement and core policies to guide future development across the Stafford Borough area. When the Core Strategy DPD is adopted it will be a Local Development Document within the Stafford Borough Local Development Framework.
