- > registered charities

Example projects


For community-based capital projects investing in 2023/2024

- Creation of footpaths and cycle paths
- > Improving visitor experience and accessibility such as providing all terrain wheelchairs
- > Retrofitting community buildings to reduce energy consumption and emissions e.g. installation of insulation, double glazing, solar paneling

For business-based capital projects investing in 2024/2025

- > Conversion of farm buildings to other business uses
- > Equipment to showcase local food and drink products.
- Electric vehicle charging points
