Stafford Borough Council is hereby giving notice that a review of all its current polling districts and polling places will take place, in accordance with the Electoral Administrations Act 2006.

We are looking for feedback on any aspect of polling districts and / or polling places currently used and invite representation and comments from interested electors within the Stafford Borough and its Parliamentary Constituencies, as well as any person or body with the expertise in relation to access for persons with any type of disability. Any person making representations should, if possible, give alternative places that may be used as polling places.

As part of the review, all submissions, relevant correspondence and Acting Returning Officer comments will be made available for public inspection.

The consultation period for the review will commence on **Monday 22 July 2019** and end on **Friday 20 September 2019**, with implementation on the 1 December 2019.
