

Recycling from the Bathroom - FAQ's

Q. What can I recycle from the Bathroom?

Plastics

- Bathroom Cleaner and Bleach Bottles
- Foundation and Cleanser/Toner Bottles
- Hand Wash Dispensers
- Mouthwash Bottles
- Plastic Wrapping
- Shampoo and Conditioner Bottles
- Shower Gel and Body Wash Bottles
- Suntan and After Sun Lotion
- Talcum Powder Containers

Metal (Aerosols)

- Air Freshener
- Deodorant
- Hairspray/Hair Mousse
- Shaving Foam

Glass

- Bath Salt Jars
- Cosmetic Jars
- Perfume and Aftershave Bottles

Cardboard

- Medication Packaging
- Tissue Boxes
- Toilet Roll Tubes
- Toiletry Packaging

Q. Don't Forget your Small Electrical Items!

A. Please remember to recycle Small Electrical Items such as electric toothbrushes, electric shavers and hairdryers by placing them in a carrier bag at the side of your blue or green bin on collection day.

Q. Do the bottles and containers need to be empty?

A. Yes, please make sure all bottles and containers are empty and rinsed where possible.

Q. Do I need to remove lids?

A. Yes, please remove lids – they can still be recycled but need to be put in the blue bin separately.

Q. Do I need to remove labels?

A. No, there is no need to remove labels from any item.

Q. Do I need to remove spray pumps?

A. No, these should be left attached to the bottle.

Q. Does it matter what colour the glass is (ie) perfume bottles?

A. No, any colour glass can be recycled in the blue bin.

Q. What can't be recycled from the bathroom at this time?

- Cotton Buds and Cotton Wool
- Nappy and Sanitary Items
- Plastic Disposable Razors
- Toothbrushes, Combs and Hair Brushes
- Wet Wipes and Make Up Wipes
