#### Introduction 1

#### **1** Introduction

**1.1** The purpose of this Settlement Assessment of services and facilities is to provide an up-to-date record of the services and facilities present in Stafford to inform the policy decision-making process for the Stafford Borough Local Development Framework (LDF).

**1.2** This technical study will guide the preparation of a settlement hierarchy for the Stafford Borough area, as a framework for managing the scale of development in different locations. A separate document covering services and facilities in the rural area has been published.

**1.3** The majority of the survey work for all the settlement assessments was carried out during the Spring and Summer 2007 by officers from the Forward Planning section of Stafford Borough Council. During the site visits local services, their location and opening times were recorded in order to confirm previous desktop based research regarding local services and facilities. This technical work is now available for consideration by the local community and key stakeholders in order to ensure the information collected is accurate. #### 2 Stafford Borough Local Plan

#### **2 Stafford Borough Local Plan**

2.1 In October 1998 the Stafford Borough Local Plan 2001 was adopted. The Local Plan identifies those settlements within the Borough which have a Residential Development Boundary (RDB). These boundaries are used around settlements within which housing development will generally be permitted.

**2.2** During the mid 1990s when these settlements were designated with an RDB, the following methodology was used. Each settlement was appraised in order to ascertain whether the following factors were relevant:

- the availability of services / facilities;
- the population size of the settlement; and
- the character and form of the settlement as expressed by the number of dwellings.

**2.3** In terms of services and facilities, settlements with three of more of the following were considered for an RDB: -

- Medical facility i.e. surgery, chemist or dentist
- Shop outlet i.e. food or general or non food;
- Educational facility i.e. nursery unit or first / primary school or secondary school;
- Post Office;
- Public transport i.e. bus available for journey to work; bus available for evening travel; or bus available for shopping;
- Village Hall;
- Church / chapel.

**2.4** Stafford has a Residential Development Boundary and has a high level of services and facilities, including many of each of the services and facilities listed above.
