Notice of the Publication of the Inspector's Report and the Adoption of the Plan for Stafford Borough: Part 2 – Publication

Stafford Borough Council has prepared the Plan for Stafford Borough: Part 2 Development Plan Document (DPD) as part of the new Local Plan for the whole of the Borough. The Plan for Stafford Borough: Part 2 DPD sets out the approach to development in the sustainable settlement hierarchy by establishing settlement boundaries for Stafford, Stone and the Key Service Villages, and boundaries for the Recognised Industrial Estates. It also includes a policy on protecting social and community facilities.

This statement has been prepared in accordance with the above Regulations and gives notice that:

- (a) the Inspector's Report on the legal compliance and soundness of the Plan for Stafford Borough: Part 2 has now been published and concludes that the Plan for Stafford Borough: Part 2 is legally compliant and sound, subject to a number of main modifications being made; and
- (b) the Plan for Stafford Borough: Part 2 was formally adopted on 31st January 2017 and incorporates the Inspector's recommended Main Modifications.

Any person who feels aggrieved by the Plan for Stafford Borough may make an application to the High Court under Section 113 of the Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004 on the grounds that:

- the Plan for Stafford Borough: Part 2 is not within the appropriate powers conferred by Part 2 of the Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004; and / or
- 2. a procedural requirement of the Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004 or it associated Regulations has not been complied with.

Any such application must be made no later than the end of the six week challenge period, starting on the Plan's adoption date of 31<sup>st</sup> January 2017 (Regulation 17 parts (c) & (d)).
