

CHARNLEY ROAD PARK IMPROVEMENTS

The masterplan for Charnley Road Park has been prepared by Red Kite Network Limited in conjunction with Stafford Borough Council, the local community and ward members.

Key Features:

1. Seating area looking over grassed space surrounded by meadow and nature area.
2. Pictorial meadow and nature area with woodland and wetland planting to enhance existing boggy areas.
3. Play garden for young children and babies with natural play features, soft planting and equipment for toddlers.
4. Picnic area with benches situated close to play areas and with views over grassed space for informal play.
5. Junior play space with a variety of equipment enabling children of all ages to play together.
6. Activity space for teens and older children with challenging play equipment and hangout space.
7. Street style skatepark with a variety of skate features set within an attractive plaza landscape.
8. Existing fenced ball games area refurbished and resurfaced.
9. New path around park periphery for dog walkers and people exercising, links with entrances to new housing and existing path network to form circular route.
10. Outdoor gym.
11. Formal football provision.
