Review terminology of 'Strategic Frameworks' in paragraph 13.21

Following the hearing session on 1 November 2013 the Council has considers the terminology of Strategic Frameworks in paragraph 13.21. To provide clarification the Council propose to replace the words Strategic Frameworks with Master Plans in paragraph 13.21 to read as follows:

"... in the on-going preparation of **Master Plans** ~~Strategic Frameworks~~ for these sites."

In addition the Council propose to amend the first sentence of paragraph 13.18 as set out below:

"... associated infrastructure and other site requirements, to prepare **Master Plans** ~~Strategic Frameworks~~."

In addition the Council propose to amend the first sentence of paragraph 13.19 as set out below:

"A particularly important issue addressed through the work on the **Master Plans** ~~Strategic Frameworks~~ is the approach to developer contributions ..."
